SPARK: Seniors Participation in Advancing Digital Resilience and Green Knowledge

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EQUALINE is pleased to launch SPARK, an Erasmus+ adult education project designed to support older adults in strengthening their digital resilience and green knowledge. The project responds to two important needs of today's society: helping seniors use digital tools with more confidence and introducing them to practical ways of living and learning more sustainably.

SPARK will bring together adult learners and educators in a series of international learning activities in Spain and Bulgaria. Through non-formal education, participants will explore topics related to digital literacy, online safety, access to essential European services, environmental awareness and sustainable everyday practices. The project is designed to be inclusive, practical and accessible for adults with limited digital experience.

With SPARK, EQUALINE aims to create a learning experience that is both useful and empowering. The project will also strengthen cooperation with European partners, improve educational methods in adult learning and develop resources that can be used beyond the project itself. In this way, SPARK will contribute not only to the growth of the participants, but also to the long-term development of the organisation and its educational work.

What SPARK will do:

- Support older adults in building digital and green competences.
- Provide international learning opportunities in Spain and Bulgaria.
- Promote inclusion, lifelong learning and active participation.
- Develop educational tools based on DigComp 2.2 and GreenComp.
- Strengthen European cooperation in adult education.

SPARK is an important step toward more inclusive, relevant and future-oriented adult education, empowering older learners to participate more fully in both digital life and sustainable living.
